

After their ordination, our priests dedicate their lives to serving Christ and His people in our parishes, hospitals, schools, chaplaincies, prisons and in service to the needy, throughout S-London, Kent and Surrey. We are blessed to have six men in formation to the Priesthood for our Archdiocese. However, it costs £30,000/year to sponsor each seminarian. They study for 6 years before being ordained a Catholic priest. We therefore rely on your generous support and prayers.

COMBATTING HUMAN TRAFFICKING

On Tuesday 17 May, 7.15pm for 7.30pm in the Lounge: Sr Imelda Poole, a leading spokesperson for anti-trafficking initiatives, and President of the Religious in

Europe Networking Against Trafficking and Exploitation (RENATE), will talk about the work of RENATE and her Community's work to rescue, reintegrate, and rehabilitate trafficked and exploited Albanian women, which includes setting up 16 businesses throughout Albania, to decrease women's risk of exploitation.
