

### **PARISH BUDGET 2018**

The Finance Committee has now published a budget for 2018. We are pleased to report that there has been a 15% increase in income from the planned giving appeal, for which many thanks. The

Committee has, however, reluctantly approved a budget with a deficit of £41,000; the reason being that apart from the increase in the salaries over 2017, there is a number of unavoidable building maintenance items for which bills will fall due this year. The position will be carefully monitored as running a deficit on 'revenue' items is not sustainable in the longer term.
