Having a Mary Heart in a Martha World

In todays gospel we have a typical family scene. Martha has a sudden influx visitors all expecting to be entertained, Mary, her sister, instead of giving a hand and helping her get the meal ready, places herself at the feet of Jesus to listen to his teachings. You get a real sense of frustration on Martha's part as she is left to get on with things and without Mary's help. You can sense Martha's annoyance with Mary. She even approaches lesus himself to ask him to tell Mary to give her a hand, but he uses the opportunity to give a teaching that where there is a choice it is



better to be silent in the presence of the Lord than to be busy about the cares of this world. It seems a hard thing to say. We feel sorry for Martha who was trying to do everything to make guests comfortable and without fed, sister's help. She might have expected Mary to give a hand, but Mary is comforted by the words of Jesus giving her permissions to stay

and listen to his teachings. Poor Martha is left to get on with it. And the lesson for us? We, too, are called to prioritise our time as Jesus points out. Time spent with him in prayer is not time misspent. It should take precedence over the day to day demands on our time. We are each of us a Martha or a Mary, both called to give him time in our lives, if in different ways.
