WHERE TO BEGIN

The Archbishop requires that you must give at least six months' notice of your intention to marry in the church. This is to allow time for the necessary paperwork and preparation.

You are asked to fill in a form giving the details of your proposed marriage. This can be done either on line, in the office or over the phone. When completed the proposed date for the wedding will be entered in the Parish diary in pencil and the word 'entered' added to the form. The form should be left for the parish priest, Canon John Clark. He or one of the other clergy will then contact you and arrange to meet.
