National Youth Sunday

In November 2020, Pope Francis called for a relaunch of World Youth Day and he asks the global Catholic community to celebrate this day on the Solemnity of Christ the King.

National Youth Sunday is a day for the world to recognise and celebrate the young people in our local church communities. The theme for this year is: 'RISE UP'. The theme reflects a call to stand up again, together, to find fresh strength and to help others to rise up too. It reminds us that we are to encourage young people to use their energy, gifts, talents in new ways.

When speaking about the importance of the role young people play in our communities Pope Francis said: 'Young people, what great potential you have in your hands! What great strength you have in your hearts!'

In our parish we see the gifts and energy of our young people in lots of ways: through welcoming, reading at Mass, assisting the sacramental programmes, our parish youth group.

We are called to journey alongside the



young people of our parish in their faith and accompany them as Jesus demonstrated on the road to Emmaus. In an ever-changing world it is important we recognise the challenges faced by our young people and help equip them to rise up and be strengthened in their faith as a foundation for their lives.

AID TO THE CHURCH IN NEED

'Breaking the Silence' Appeal:
John Pontifex and Jerry
Lohan will be making an appeal in our parish, this weekend, on behalf of Aid to the
Church in Need. ACN supports persecuted Christians in over 140 countries around the world and is currently involved in 5,000 projects.
This appeal will follow the launch of a major report by
ACN, which highlights the increased threats and attacks

that Nigerian Christians are facing daily. In June this year, St Francis Xavier parish, in Ondo diocese, Nigeria, was the subject of a horrific terrorist attack, killing 40 people, including children, and seriously injuring 80 survivors. We can now confirm that Bishop Jude Arogundade, from Ondo Diocese, Nigeria, will be flying in to speak together with John Pontifex and Jerry Lohan at the following Masses this weekend:
