2. Minutes of last meeting

4. 'Be Well Hub' -

Diocese is enthusiastic about the 'Be Well Hub ' and interested in encouraging other parishes within the diocese to become recognised as 'Be Well Hubs' too. We have a number of volunteers being trained, both to support various groups such as the Memory Lane Club and the Thursday Group, and to talk to parishioners about their wellbeing at the monthly continental breakfasts.

We are applying for a microgrant to buy a laptop to help those who struggle to access online resources, especially resources that help improve health and wellbeing. Nina B has volunteered to help with this. This is likely to benefit members of the Memory Lane Club in particular.

Graham Kennedy is also talking to Merton Council about how the Be Well Hub could help the Council meet its public health objectives.
