Attitudes in Prayer

Jesus had a way with words. Often in the stories he told he created characters that would have been familiar to his listeners. Today in the Gospel we have the parable of the tax collector and the Pharisee. The boastful Pharisee would have been familiar to those listening to Jesus. He had already condemned them for seeking to have the best places at banquets or praying publicly to attract attention. The



antics of the Pharisee in the gospel story would not have surprised people. The tax collector on the other hand may not have been so familiar a figure at least not in the temple or the synagogue. Because of their unpopularity they would probably have

avoided such places. That makes the parable of Jesus more powerful. In the contrast of personalities and in their very different approach to prayer they are challenges to us of our standing in the face of our Father in heaven. Are we the conceited Pharisee comfortable in how we manage our relationship with God, or are we the realist tax collector, aware of our sinfulness and the need for God's mercy?

PRAYER FOR THE YEAR OF MERCY Lord Jesus, send your Spirit and consecrate every one of us with its anointing, so that the Jubilee of Mercy may be a year of grace from the Lord, and your Church, with renewed enthusiasm, may bring good news to the poor, proclaim liberty to captives and the oppressed, and restore sight to the blind.
