

Preparing for Lent

In two weeks' time we begin the holy season of Lent. Originally a time of prayer and fasting for those adults preparing to be baptised at Easter it was developed by the Church as a time when all Christians deepen their relationship with God through the three great tools of prayer fasting and good works. In preparing for Lent we won't go far wrong if we take each of these tools and apply them to our daily lives. How during this Lent can we deepen our prayer life? There are three ways we can move forward here. Lets start with our private prayer. Could we give ten or twenty minutes a day extra time for private prayer and devotions. A simple prayer book is a great resource for this. Second, what about



public prayer and devotions, attending a weekday Mass, or the Stations of the Cross or adoration, or the weekly Lenten service. Finally by attending one of the many Lenten talks or events around the area. Fasting, the second tool is easy enough to identify, it just needs a conscious effort to cut out the chocolate, or the drink or the smokes, or sugar. But don't forget anything we save by cutting something from our diet should go to a good cause. That leads to the third tool, good works. This covers a myriad of activities from saving your

small change during Lent to contribute to а charitable cause to giving some of your time to a person or organisation in need, to having that clear out at home for the charity shop down the road, to visiting an elderly person who may be housebound, or with few to visit. There are lots of different ways we can do something for Lent. What is important is that we spend a little time before Lent starts to decide what we want to do - and don't leave it to Ash Wednesday! Lent is a time of great blessing, it is to be savoured. Hopefully when you celebrate the feast of the resurrection at Easter you will be able to say that through your own Lenten exercises you have also shared in the resurrection.
